- Prepare and implement EarlyON programs for children 0 - 6 and their parents, grandparents & caregivers.
- Interact with parents, grandparents and caregivers in a supportive manner.
- Identify to Program Coordinators/Manager situations where adults or children require extra support or resources.
- Observe and document the interests and learning of children.
- Model best practices in playing and interacting with children.
- Lift and move equipment within our programs as needed, including setting up and tearing down.
- Follow safety and hygiene protocols, to maintain a safe program and work space
